



## **RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC**

No. 209 of 13 March 2020, No. 209

### **on adoption of crisis measures**

Following up on Government Resolution No. 194 of 12 March 2020 whereby, in accordance with Art. 5 and 6 of Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll. on Security in the Czech Republic, the government has declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to the threat to health presented with the proven incidence of coronavirus (identified as SARS CoV-2) in the territory of the Czech Republic and in the sense of Section 5 (a) to (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000 Coll. on Crisis Management and on amendment to certain Acts (the Crisis Act), as amended, for solution of the arisen crisis situation, the government has hereby decided to adopt crisis measures in the sense of Section 5(c) and Section 6(1)(c) of the Crisis Act.

With effect from 12:00 noon on 13 March 2020

#### **the Government orders**

1. all citizens of the Czech Republic and foreign nationals with temporary or permanent residence in the Czech Republic residing in the territory of the Czech Republic for over 90 days, or persons employed in the Czech Republic returning to the Czech Republic, from a risk area as specified by the Minister of Health pursuant to Government Resolution of 12 March 2020 after this Government Resolution becomes effective to inform their registering healthcare services provider of general practical medicine or practical medicine for children and youths, or, if they do not have such registering provider, then any provider in the field of general practical medicine or practical medicine for children and youths of this fact by telephone or by other remote communication channel immediately following their return to the Czech Republic. This obligation does not apply to persons covered by an exemption granted by the Minister of the Interior pursuant to Government Resolution No. 198 of 12 March 2020 and No. 203 of March 13 2020,
2. all providers in the field of general practical medicine or practical medicine for children and youths to prescribe quarantine lasting 14 days pursuant to Act No. 2(7)(a) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll. to all persons with temporary or permanent residence in the Czech Republic residing in the territory of the Czech Republic for over 90 days, or persons employed in the Czech Republic, returning to the Czech Republic from a risk area as specified by the Minister of Health pursuant to Government Resolution of 12 March 2020 after this Government Resolution becomes effective,
3. all persons to whom the obligation specified in item 1 above does not apply to inform to inform their registering healthcare services provider of general practical medicine or practical medicine for children and youths, or, if they do not have such registering provider, then any provider in the

field of general practical medicine or practical medicine for children and youths of this fact by telephone or by other remote communication channel immediately,

4. all truck drivers, bus drivers, airline flight crews, train drivers, train crews and wheel-tappers, boat captains and water vessel crews, road management vehicle crews transiting the territories of risk areas or performing road haulage in the territory of such risk areas as specified by the Minister of Health pursuant to Government Resolution No. 198 of 12 March 2020 are advised to limit direct contact with the local personnel in the territory of such risk areas to the maximum.
